



2009 New York State Masters & Juniors State Track Championships

Friday, July 24th - Sunday, July 26th, 2009

Held under USA Cycling event permit

PRE-REGISTRATION ONLY!!!!

All USCF rules apply. Riders must have a USCF license and be in good standing with USA Cycling. Unlicensed riders may purchase a one-day license for \$10 per day of competition. Top 3 New York state residents will be awarded state championship medals. Out of state riders are welcome to participate, but are ineligible for state championship medals. Riders must hold annual USA Cycling license to be eligible for state medals. Championship events will be run in the following classes:

Master Men 30+ (Cat 1-4 only)
Master Men 40+ (Cat 1-4 only)
Master Men 50+

Master Women 30+
Junior Men 17-18
Junior Men 10-16

Junior Women

If the following categories have less than 5 riders (Junior Men 17-18, Junior Men 10-16, Junior Women, Master Men 50+, Junior Women), fields will be combined by discretion of the promoter to achieve a field of at least 5 riders. If the following categories have less than 10 riders (Master Men 30+, Master Men 40+), fields will be combined by discretion of the promoter to achieve a field of at least 10 riders.

The omnium will be based on the top 5 riders in each event receiving 7, 5, 3, 2, and 1 point (except Match Sprint – places top 3 – 7,4,2). The highest total after all events will be the winner, with top 3 New York riders in each class (annual license holders only!) receiving state medals.

PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED. Riders can pre-register until Thursday, July 23rd on BikeReg.com (direct link will be posted on Kissena's track web page) or mail in entries that are **received** no later than July 22nd to Alan Atwood, 62 Timber Ridge Dr, Holbrook, NY 11741. Checks are to be made payable to Alan Atwood. For championship categories, entry fees are \$12 (\$5 for juniors) per event or \$35 (\$15 for juniors) for the entire weekend. All fees include USCF insurance surcharges. Number pickup will be on Friday from 4:30pm-5:45pm, Saturday and Sunday from 8:30am-9:45am. Riders under 18 years of age must have parent or guardian present to sign race waiver.

JUNIOR RIDERS UNDER 17: You must configure your gearing to conform to maximum gear limits as outlined in the USA Cycling Rulebook; 15-16: 6.78 meters (22'3") (48x15); 13-14: 6.36 meters (20'10.5") (48x16); 10-12: 6.00 meters (19'8") (48x17). Rollout will be available before the event for those that wish to check their gears. Official rollout will be conducted after each race.

Explanation of Races

Omnium

- The top 5 riders in each event will receive 7, 5, 3, 2, and 1 point for all eligible omnium races, except for match sprints (see section below).
- Riders who are disqualified from an event cannot receive omnium points for that event and the riders next in the standings will move up and earn the higher amount of points.
- A rider who is disqualified from more than 1 race will not be eligible for the overall omnium.
- Ties in overall omnium points will be broken by placing in the last race that either of the riders participated in.

Individual Time Trial

- 2 riders will start at opposite ends of the track on the pursuit line (except for 500m – one at a time).
- The riders do 2 ½ laps for kilos, 1 ¼ laps for 500's.

- Drafting is not allowed, and is grounds for disqualification
- The top 5 in time will receive standard omnium points for the overall event.

Team Sprint

- 2 teams of 3 riders (men) or 2 riders (women) each will start at opposite ends of the track on the pursuit line.
- Each rider of the team will lead one full lap on the track. Once the lap is completed, that rider will pull uptrack in the designated 30 meter zone (15m before and after the pursuit line) and leave the track without hindering other riders competing.
- The 2 fastest teams will race again for 1st place, and the 3rd and 4th fastest teams will race again for 3rd place (if necessary)
- Other teams will be placed by qualifying time.

Match Sprints

- There will be flying 200m TT's for seeding. Riders will line up by category and bib number and be sent onto the track by the starter.
- Depending on field size, the top 9 or 12 will qualify for the 1st round.
- All 1st round sprints will be at least 3-up.
- Repechage will be utilized only to obtain a desired amount of riders needed for the next round.
- Semi-Finals and Finals will be one ride only.
- In all races, distance of race is 2 laps. In first and semi-final rounds, riders will lineup along the rail in order of the highest number seed in front and the lowest number seed in the back. The finals will have riders being held on the start line with the highest number drawn in the sprinters lane and the lowest number seed uptrack.
- Omnium points will be determined by the order of finish in the final sprint, with 7 points for 1st, 4 points for 2nd, and 2 points for 3rd.

Scratch Race

- 1st rider to the line in the prescribed amount of laps wins.
- Top 5 will receive omnium points.

Points Race

- Top 4 in each sprint will receive 5, 3, 2, and 1 point.
- No double points on final sprints
- Riders who lap the main field will receive 20 points. Riders who get lapped by the main field will lose 20 points.
- Rider with the most points wins the race. Ties in points will be broken by placing in final sprint.
